

Harvesting Regulation in Canada

“In Canada harvest levels are strictly controlled and regulated. Provincial government agencies conduct or review, all harvest level calculations and are ultimately responsible for setting all annual harvest levels within their respective jurisdictions. By law, forest managers are required by law to promptly regenerate all harvested areas, although the method of regeneration may vary, regardless of method compliance is strictly monitored and enforced

Less than one percent of the total forest land in Canada is harvested each year. Harvesting forests provides the products needed by society - products that emit fewer greenhouse gases and come from a renewable source. Through careful management of our forests, society can continue to garner these benefits.”
